

British Sailing Team Code of Conduct

All members of the British Sailing Team have a responsibility to uphold its reputation and legacy. We want all British Sailing Team members to be able to fulfil their potential within a safe and enjoyable environment.

This code of conduct applies to anybody representing the British Sailing Team (sailors, coaches and staff) and should be read in conjunction with the WCP Performance Agreement, the RYA Coaches Code of Conduct and the RYA and EIS Staff Handbooks.

As a British Sailing Team member, you recognize that your conduct will reflect on past, present and future team members, the RYA, our commercial partners, UK Sport (including the National Lottery) and the sport as a whole. Accordingly, you agree to conduct yourself in a proper manner whilst a member of the British Sailing Team including:

- 1. Upholding the British Sailing Team Values and complying with the RYA Racing Charter;
- 2. Making a positive commitment to supporting and achieving the aims and objectives of the World Class Programme;
- 3. Displaying high standards of behaviour and not bringing yourself or by association the RYA, our commercial partners, UK Sport (including the National Lottery) or the sport into disrepute;
- 4. Respecting the rights, dignity and worth of every person, acting in an inclusive, fair and non-discriminatory manner;
- 5. Treating all members of the British Sailing Team and the wider sailing community and their property with respect;
- 6. Recognising that your actions in person, in media and online reflect on the British Sailing Team, our commercial partners, UK Sport (including the National Lottery) and the sport;
- 7. Promoting a culture of clean sport and abiding by all anti-doping requirements.

As a member of the British Sailing Team, you understand that breaches of this Code may be subject to action under the relevant disciplinary policy.
